

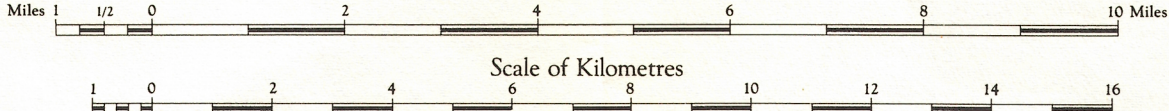
The declination of the compass needle at any place along a red line is the declination given on that red line. At other places the declination is between that given on the neighbouring red lines and at the place marked A, the declination is between N. 12° W. and N. 12° E. The yearly declination of the compass needle are decreasing 1 minute annually.

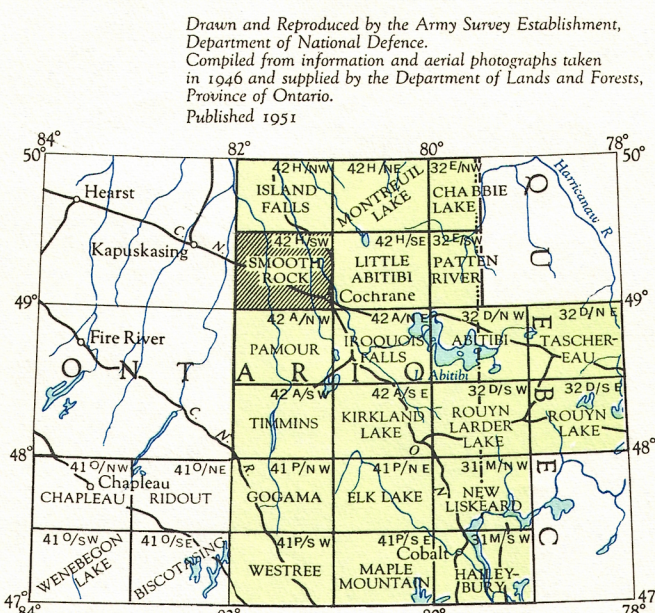
