



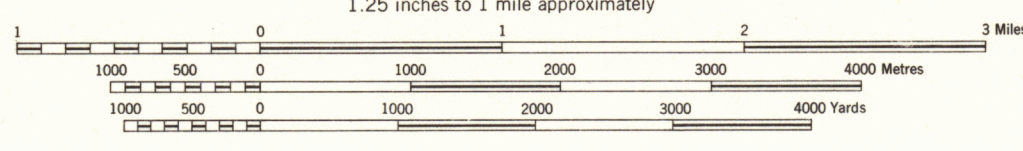

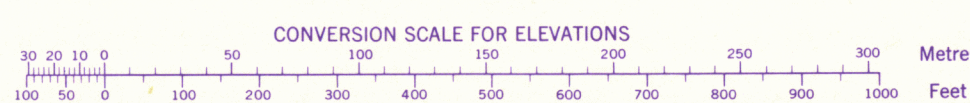
NEILAND BAY

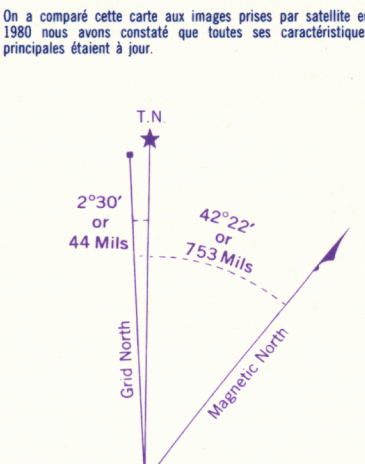
