TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES

EXAMPLE: STREAM JUNCTION

SQUARE: Read letters of 100,000 m. square VC

EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point.

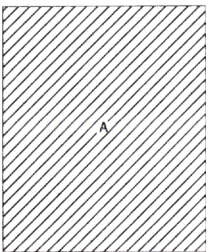
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point. Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point.

MILITARY GRID REFERENCE (to nearest 1,000 metres) VC5402

If reporting beyond 18° in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation as: 12XVC5402

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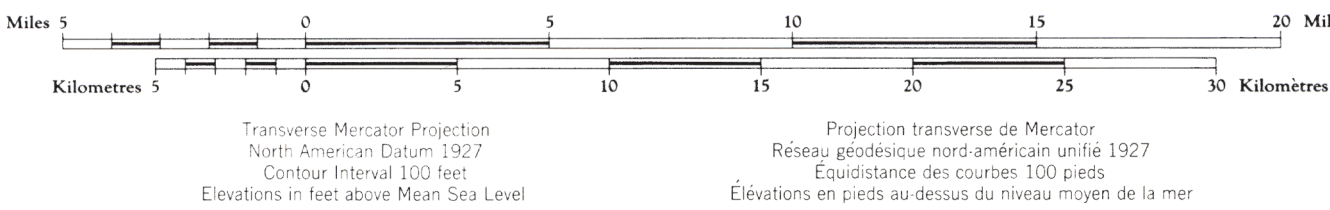

The daily change of the North Magnetic Pole renders the magnetic compass useless in this area

1964 Magnetic declination for this map varies from 111°00'easterly at the centre of the west edge to 114°40'easterly at the centre of the east edge.

This map was checked in 1980 and found to be up-to-date in all major features.

- Roads: Routes: loose surface, de graviers, dry weather; cart track, trail, de terre, sentier, période sèche
- Boundary monument: Borre frontiere
- Pingo: Buttes de terre
- Depression contours: Courbes de cuvette
- Cliff or low relief: Falaise ou relief peu accentué
- Esker: Esker
