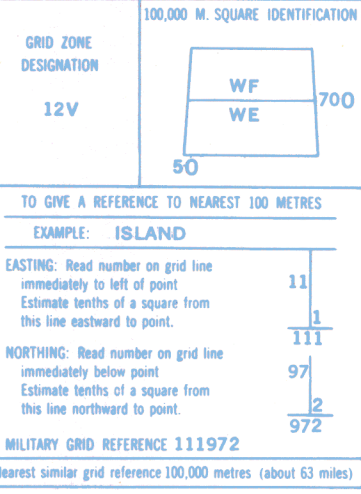


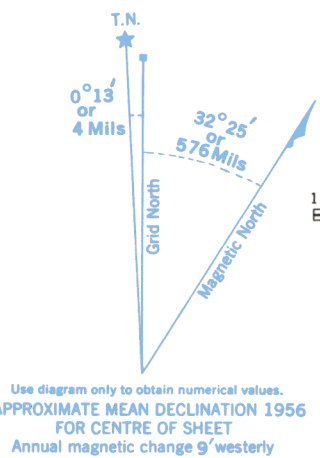

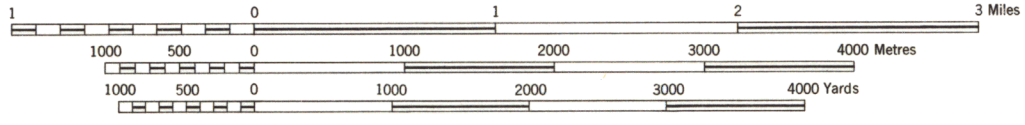


ONE THOUSAND METRE

ZONE 12



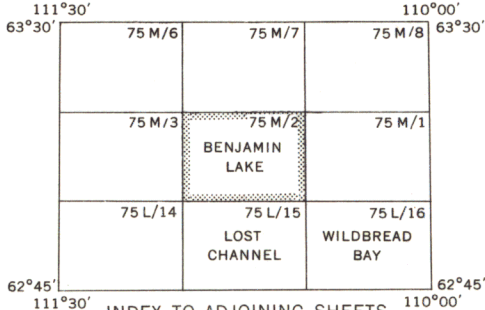
